



## **THE NEWPORT NEWS GREEN FOUNDATION NEIGHBORHOOD ENTRANCEWAY GRANT PROGRAM**

In partnership with the City of Newport News, the Newport News Green Foundation awards grants up to \$3500 to residents wishing to improve the entranceways to their neighborhoods. Funds can be requested to cover one-time costs related to new neighborhood sign installation, complementing landscape installation and improvements to existing signs and landscaping. Qualifying neighborhoods must be located within the City of Newport News, have obtained signatures of at least 25 homeowners (and/or 15% of homeowners)\*, and submit a completed application (which includes design/landscape plans, cost estimates, budget breakdown, and project leaders). Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and are awarded until funds are depleted for the fiscal year. Please allow 4 to 6 weeks for applications to be processed. *(Please note: Funds are awarded for single projects and cannot be distributed for on-going maintenance of landscaping and/or signs).*

*\*Neighborhood or Homeowners Associations can submit applications without signatures, but must submit covenants or a letter from their representing attorney that confirm their authority to make decisions related to entranceway signage and landscaping on behalf of homeowners in their neighborhoods.*
